

CLEANING GUIDE

How to Get Set Stains Out of White Linens



MAKEUP

Apply dish soap/detergent and rinse from the back with cold water. Dab with 3% hydrogen peroxide, then rinse. Wash, air dry, repeat until stains vanish.



COFFEE

Mix ½ tsp. dish soap, 1 tbsp. white vinegar, and 1 qt. hot water. Soak fabric for 15-30 mins. Rinse with warm water, blot with rubbing alcohol using a sponge, then rinse again.



FOOD

Combine equal parts warm water and white vinegar. Soak fabric for 15-30 mins. Wash and air dry. Repeat if needed.



WINE

Pretreat the stain with water, then soak fabric in white vinegar for 30 mins. Cover the stain with a paste of baking soda and hydrogen peroxide—let it sit for 30 mins. Gently scrub with a soft brush or cloth. Rinse with cold water, then wash.



BLOOD

Dab hydrogen peroxide on the stain, then rinse. If necessary, soak fabric in cold water and salt for 30 mins. Wash linens in a normal cycle with cold water.



GREASE & OIL

Apply a paste of cornstarch and water to both sides of the stain. Let this set for an hour then brush it away. Dab the area with dish soap on both sides, rub it in with your fingers, then rinse stain-side down. Launder and air dry.
